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"Christmas Message" 22 Dec,2010

Hearty freternal greetings to the WTT brotherhood.

Today is a great occasion and a holy day. Tonight a great initiate is born. The sun rays that we see tomorrow have a saviour principle in them. Tonight all the great Masters perform a grand ritual tomorrow "The ritual for the birth of the saviour". The birth of the saviour happens every year in the midnight hours of 22nd December. As Jesus Christ was born on 22nd December, he is also called a saviour. Saviour is none other than the Lord himself coming down. He is always present in our Sahasrara in a state of Sleep. He comes down from there and uplifts us if we are prepared and have the required orientation. This grand ritual is performed by the Grand Masters for over thousands of years for the upliftment of the humanity. If we know it, orient ourselves towards it before going to sleep tonight, then we may have a divine experience.

We have gathered here to recollect the importance of this day. We are purified by reading, hearing and recollecting the story of Jesus Christ. He has been one of the Masters who has guided Master EK in his life and mission to love and to serve the people. So to move closer to Master Jesus, Master EK has served as a bridge. Master EK had great liking for Jesus Christ from his childhood. He read the Bible completely and used to explain some great concepts given in the Bible. Master EK gave in one of his books "Bhagavata Rahasya Prakasham" that Jesus is the only initiate in the recent Kali Yuga to have performed the grand ritual of "Man Sacrifice".

Jesus was a very beautiful man. Master Jesus studied all the sciences completely. He moved along with everyone around him just as a simple person. We can observe the same quality in Lord Rama, Krishna and even in Master EK. The path of Jesus is the path of the Hierarchy.

We should have an image of Christ in our house. It has nothing to do with our religion. Religion is different and truth is different. I was happy when I saw this image of Jesus Christ on the dais. It was given to me by a father of a Cathedral Church in Barcelona, Spain in 1988.

Jesus is one grand Master who would respond to any sincere call of a devotee without any bias. If he takes birth in us, it is the birth of the saviour in us. He taking birth in us means the chakra at our heart centre growing in light and becoming a lotus. It is the same as the Lord taking birth in us. This happens only when one is good-natured and willing to serve anyone in need.

Actually the story of Christ before birth and after Resurrection is put aside and not known to many due to religious indifferences. I will try to give some important aspects in the life of Jesus Christ.

Jesus was born to Joseph, a 7th ray grand Master and Mary, a disciple of Master DK. Jesus was a great devotee of Lord Krishna in his previous lives and after the 2nd stage of initiation he took birth as Jesus in Israel. After the birth of Jesus, the grand Masters visited the place of his birth and gave some gifts to his parents and told them that this boy should be sent to Himalayas at the age of 12. Joseph gives him all the initial training in life from the age of 5 to 12. At the age of 12, Jesus was taken to a temple in Jerusalem. It is a very huge golden temple. There were lot of business activities taking place in the temple itself and everything became commercial.

Jesus gets a sort of anger seeing everything what was happening in the temple because he came with a lot of expectation that this temple would be a pure place of the divine. He starts arguing with the priests in that temple. He also finds fault with the rituals being performed as they were against what was given in the scriptures. We can see this even now in our temples. Everything is done casually and there is no purity in action.

Midst of all this, he was brought out of the temple and was handed over to a business man from Tibet, who comes on the purpose of taking Jesus to India. Informing everyone that Jesus is lost, Mary and Joseph return to their place. He was joined in the greatest of schools of learning at those times and learnt all the sciences and scriptures in just 6 years from 12 to 18.

Then he went to Puri and visited the temple there. He starts arguing with the priests in the temple and tells them that you are doing many things wrong and this is not what is given in the Vedas. He wins all the arguments against them and the priests felt that this man must be killed before he does any more damage to their status. That night the man from Tibet, who brought Jesus to India, took him to Nepal by travel through air when Jesus was asleep and Jesus wakes up in Nepal in a room. He did not know where he was and sees around and understands that it is some school. It is actually the ashram of learning of Kratu Maharshi who is also called Rakoji or St. Germain. He is none other the Lokayatha mentioned in the book "Music of the Soul" in his previous birth. With the touch of Lord Krishna, he became a Master and has been working to promote Vedic Dharma for over 5000 years from then to now.

So that Master joins Jesus into his school. By seeing that Master, Jesus feels the presence of his father. This is because it is the same being who took birth as his father in Israel and also as teacher in India at the same time.

There he was taught some more rituals and the science of magic (ceremonial order). He also got some glimpses of previous lives during that period of study. Then again that man from Tibet comes and Jesus understands that time has come for him to move. He travels for some time along with that man and learns some more subjects in that travel on foot. Then Jesus was taken to an Ashram in Tibet where he meets many grand disciples who attained immortality. He stays there for 3 days and many transformations take place in him during that period.

Then he was taken to attend the Vaisakha Festival in the Vaisakha Valley attended by many grand Masters and he experiences the presence of Masters Maitreya, Maruvu and Devapi. Later he

meets each of them directly and the 3 of them give him initiation into different aspects of his future work.

All completion of this learning period of 12 years, he goes back to Israel via Egypt at the age of 30. During the travel he meets many grand Masters in Egypt who were working with Master St. Germain. Already by that time, he brother Yohannes gathers people together saying that a saviour would come. Yohannes sees Jesus first time at the river Jordon and tells everyone that the saviour has come and they will have to follow him from now on.

Jesus starts teaching them beginning with the law of karma. He teaches the fishermen, workers and other people on these lines. He also starts teaching in the temples. He gave many parables which are given in the bible.

He does many miracles. He brings back a boy to life who died untimely. He asks fishermen to put back the fish they caught into water and offers them the equivalent money. In this way, he propagated non-violence. He never ate non-vegetarian food. He also tells that what is being followed and preached in the temples is different from what is given in the Scriptures.

Then he was invited to the Temple of Jerusalem by some priests who felt that he was "Son of God". When he was entering the temple, a blind man falls at his feet and asks him to give his sight. Jesus prays to the Lord and that man gets his sight. He then says "You are God." Jesus replies "I am not God but I am a Son of God. It is to glorifying me that he has done this to you through me". Then he goes into the temple and starts talking with the priests there. They ask him "Are you the Son of God" Jesus says "Yes! I AM". Then they ask him why you are criticizing our rituals and activities. He replies "there is nothing wrong in telling that something is wrong and this is right". This was as per the instructions given by Master Maruvu who tells him to bring about reforms in the society wherever necessary. A long discussion goes on and the priests were not happy with Jesus and Jesus goes away.

In Jerusalem, there used to a practice in a temple and in that town. It contains the holy waters that would cure any disease but on Saturday and Sunday no one would be allowed into the temple and even doctors would not attend to patients. All shops, even medical shops are closed. One man who was suffering from a severe disease comes to bathe in those holy waters of the temple. He comes from a long distance and reached on Saturday and was not allowed into the temple. Then Jesus Christ takes him into the temple and makes him take bath in that water.

The religious heads who saw this get angry and tell him that you have done a great sin. No one is allowed to take bath in the holy water on Saturday and Sunday. They ask him "Don't you know the rules?" Jesus replies "I know but it is not correct. None of our Scriptures mention that a suffering person should not be saved from dying." Later a woman comes to him and asks him that she also wants to be cured of her disease. Then he cures her just by water from his hand. The religious heads say "It is a rule nothing should be done on Saturday and Sunday and you should follow it". Jesus replies "Then you should also stop breathing air. Do that first." The priests and the heads had no answer but they get angry and decided that he should be imprisoned.

Everyone in Jerusalem started to like Christ and his teachings because he was teaching the truth with love for the beings. They used to feel very happy in his presence of Christ. In the meantime, the religious heads, secretly plan to catch and imprison him but Christ goes on doing his work and becomes very popular among the people.

During that time, the son of Roman head or minister suffered from a severe disease which could not be cured by any doctor. All medicines were tried. He wanted to take his son to Jesus but was afraid that those against Jesus would agitate. He alone goes to Jesus's house and tells him the situation and requests him to save his son. Jesus says "Go home. Your son would be fine." The Roman head goes home and is very happy to know that his son is fine.

Jesus also made the shops and other businesses taking place within the temple premises to be removed saying purity of the temple must be maintained. So these shopkeepers and businessmen joined hands with the religious heads with the intention of imprisoning Jesus.

One day, as he was moving around, he sees a woman being beaten with stones by a group of people. He hugs her and protects her from the stone beating. Then the group stops throwing stones and tells Jesus that she is a thief and should be beaten to death. Then Jesus asks her "What did you steal?" The woman replied "I work as a servant in a house of landlord. A Grand feast took place at his house and at the end of the party; they threw away the left over food. I collected that food to feed my children". Then Jesus questions the group "Is that a thieving act? You are so arrogant that you feel so. If we still want to beat her, then beat me first." Then the people realize and go away. That woman thanks Jesus and goes away.

One day, Jesus and his disciple were traveling. His disciple feels hungry and asks Jesus if he was hungry. Jesus replies "You are asking me because you are hungry. Anyway we will see if we can find something to eat". They find a tree nearby. The disciple tries to take some fruits off the tree. Jesus says "First you need to ask the tree because it does not owe you anything" the disciple asks "How?" Then Jesus touches the tree and prays for sometime and a fruit falls off the tree automatically. The disciple picks it up and eats the fruit. Jesus says "these are basic things that one should know and follow before practicing anything else. You should ask before taking anything from anyone if that does not belong to you. That is the only way the Lord's presence would grow in us. It is no use if one reads Scriptures and Scriptures."

He also used to say "Love your neighbours." Then a disciple questions "What do you mean by it" then Jesus tells a story.

"One person falls on the road unconsciously due to severe heat of the sun. One person traveling by a horse on that road sees this person and just passes. Another person came on a horse, got down the horse, saw this person and climbed the horse and went off. The 3rd person came on a horse. He got down, brought that person to consciousness, gave him some water, gave him some food which he had and put him on his horse and took him to a shelter. He is neither a friend, a relative nor did he see him anytime previously. Such a one is called the Good Samaritan. The act of service that he has done to a stranger is what is called love. Neighbour is none other than a fellow being in need of help. If you ignore

such neighbours and do your work, go to a temple everyday, perform the grandest of rituals; it is all of no use. The Lord will come to you if you do so.”

So these were some of the acts performed by Jesus Christ and teaching given by him. As time passed some disciples gathered around him but most of them gathered seeing his miracles but not due to experiencing his love and his teachings. There were very few who knew in complete and his mother was one among them.

In the meantime, the priests, religious heads and businessmen build up an agitation against him and report to the Roman prefect. They make false reports to him. Jesus was captured and brought to the court and many people gathered to view the proceedings. The roman head knew that Jesus did nothing wrong as his wife told him but the religious heads pressurize him that Jesus should be punished. The Roman head asks why should he be punished. The religious heads say “He is criticizing our religion and our religious practices.” So it was decided he must be imprisoned for now and the trial would continue later.

I am just giving a brief account. The story is much in detail.

There is one day called Pass Over day on which prisoners are released. The Roman summons for a meet and asks which prisoner is to be released. All the rich men and religious heads said that a fierce robber be released while others said that Jesus should be released. Though the Roman Head wanted to release Jesus, he had to yield to the word of the stronger section of people as it was a law and order issue. It was decided that Jesus is to be crucified on the cross by those religious heads.

Jesus disappears and moves from place to place completing his undone work but the Roman soldiers could not find him. At last one, he hosts a supper to all his disciples and says that he would be caught that day and one among his disciples would bring the Roman Soldiers. When the roman soldiers come and try to catch him, a disciple interrupts and cuts the ear of the soldier with a knife. Jesus feels sad and cures his ear. The Roman Soldier feels so sad that he is catching such a kind person.

Then on the day of Equinox, he was made to carry the cross and climb the hill and that night, he was put on the cross. Jesus said that he would come back after 3 days to everyone who was crying for him. He also tells this to the religious heads. “There is no death for a being and anyone can attain a state of immortality. It is given in the world Scriptures. You did not realize it and never practiced it. I will show how it can be done.”

It was Friday, new moon day and it was a cyclonic weather. Jesus was crucified on the hill. The Roman Soldiers were deputed to stay there until he dies. His mother and 2 other lady disciples stay there that night in that storm until Jesus leaves the body. All other disciples run away once Jesus was crucified. Some even deny that they are not the disciples of Jesus due to the fear that they might also be imprisoned.

The Roman soldiers take his body into a cave and close the entry of the cave with a huge stone as instructed by the religious heads as they feared that he might return. After 3 moon days, on Sunday

the 3 ladies go to the cave to see him as they believed that he would come back as promised. The huge stone at the entrance of cave was not present. They do not find his body in the cave and call for him in agony. Then he appears in a white body floating in the air and tells them to inform others that he has come back. These ladies run to the others who were hiding due to fear but they do not believe the word of these ladies. Then Jesus comes through the wall and appears before them directly and tells them to spread his word and teachings all over the world. Then Jesus disappears from there and goes to Himalayas present Kashmir in India. He stays there in a small village by name **Pehle** (Hindi word meaning first) and lives there with a physical body up to the age of 84.

Jesus is still working on the planet immortally for the upliftment of the humanity. He still gives his presence to many of his sincere disciples and is protecting them. He is closely associated with the grand Masters of Himalayas and they call him "The Great Pilgrim."

We are lucky if we get his love and follow his teachings. We are all blessed to recollect his story in a short manner and may we get into his presence. Everyone should read the Bible though it may not contain all truths but there are many truths and teachings of Jesus and other grand Masters given in it.
